- 2 accepted with minor revisions, 3 accepted with major revisions, 12 rejected including a paper with 6.3/10.
- Acceptance rate 25-30%.
- One JSAC special issue every year on emerging technologies.
- 9. A JSAC issue on Green Integrated Optical Networks proposal was submitted; led by Pin-Han Ho of the University of Waterloo.
- 10. Web Site: Managed by Chunming Qiao at a SUNY Buffalo server. Steve Weinstein is currently taking care of it.
